Facilities Management maintains a strict cleaning regime and standard cleaning frequencies in accordance with CDC guidelines and Green Seal standards for commercial and institutional cleaning services (GS-42).

FM Building Services' principal delivery objective is to provide a healthy, high-performance cleaning system, which includes quality control assurances while using a selection of environmentally responsible cleaning equipment, chemicals and techniques that are sustainable, maximize productivity and clean for health. In order to eliminate as many interruptions as possible, we take largely into consideration the coordination of service delivery and the activities in facilities, with an emphasis on classroom/instructional space readiness.

Administrative Areas (with key Access): Offices Conference Rooms	Once Weekly	 Recycling removal Dusting Vacuuming Wet mopping Wiping cleared horizontal surfaces Disinfecting door handles/contact points *Shampooing and/or scrubbing and floor refinishing are reimbursable services upon request
Restricted Areas ("off" master key access): • Research Labs, offices, etc.	Upon request	Services upon request (may be reimbursable): Room cleaning Floor cleaning/carpet shampooing Floor stripping and refinishing
Projects: Common/public areas	Annually	 Floor cleaning/carpet shampooing Floor stripping and refinishing (during summer or winter break)
