General Requirements:

- The identification of regulated wetlands and areas within the 100 year floodplain areas is required for all site development projects in accordance with Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) or U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) regulations and guidelines.
- The identification of such areas shall be the first priority toward any new project site's design development studies. The existence of these areas shall be brought to the immediate attention of the University in the initial design phase of all applicable projects.
- Any disturbance within a floodplain, waterway, tidal wetland, non-tidal wetland, or its buffer is subject to regulation.
- Approval from the appropriate reviewing agency(s) is necessary for any such disturbance or construction on campus.
